

EXEMPTION from AN(OT)O

In accordance with Article 10 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013, as amended, BCAA hereby grants the following:

BCAA/PAVE/1363

Requirement

AN(OT)O ARTICLE 73 (5) - Regulation of Small Unmanned Aircraft

- *The person in charge of a small unmanned aircraft must not fly the aircraft for the purposes of aerial work except in accordance with a permission granted by the Governor.*

Description of Exemption

Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority hereby authorizes an Exemption from AN(OT)O regulation mentioned above for any SUA operator, who is/are subject to article 73(5) of the Order, and whose SUA is/are operated in Bermuda, from holding an Aerial Works Permission required under article 73(5) of the Order, subject to the conditions and period of validity identified below.

Conditions

1. This is limited to those SUA operated within the islands of Bermuda, and
2. The Operator remains clear of all the promulgated No-Fly Zones, and
3. Cargo is not to be carried, and
4. The Operator must comply with all other sections of Article 73, and
5. Subject to compliance with the foregoing conditions, this exemption shall remain valid from the date of issue unless varied, suspended or revoked.

Validity

This Exemption shall have effect from the date of issue unless varied, suspended or revoked and supersedes Exemption PAVE/1363 dated 08 January 2021.
