

GENERAL EXEMPTION from AN(OT)O

In accordance with Article 10 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013, as amended, BCAA hereby grants the following:

BCAA/PAVE/1246 (revision)

Requirement

AN(OT)O PART 4 Article 44-1

- *A person must not act as a member of the flight crew of an aircraft registered in the Territory without holding an appropriate licence granted or rendered valid under this Order.*

Description of General Exemption

The Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority hereby authorizes a General Exemption from AN(OT)O regulation to permit holders of Airline Transport or Commercial Pilot's Licences issued under the laws of an I.C.A.O. Contracting State to the extent necessary to enable the licence holder to act as pilot of an aircraft registered in Bermuda, for the purpose of undergoing training or test to enable the licence holder to qualify under the Civil Aviation Regulations of the same I.C.A.O. Contracting State for the inclusion of a type rating in the licence, subject to the conditions and period of validity identified below.

Conditions

1. No flight shall be made pursuant to this exemption unless the certificate of airworthiness is in force with respect to the aircraft
 2. No other person shall be carried in the aircraft except:
 - a) a person carried as a member of the flight crew in compliance with the Order
 - b) a person authorised by the State of Licence Issue to witness the aforesaid training or tests or to conduct the aforesaid tests, or
 - c) a person being carried for the purpose of being trained or tested as a member of the flight crew of an aircraft, providing the pilot in command of the aircraft is a holder of an appropriate licence
 3. The person authorised to witness the aforesaid training or tests or to conduct the aforesaid tests must be in possession of a Bermuda Certificate of Licence Validation; and
 4. No flight shall be made under this exemption without the permission of the competent authority of the State in whose airspace the flight takes place.
