Introduction of Charges for Dangerous Goods Oversight Services



1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Prior to 2022, the Bermuda Civil Aviation Authority (BCAA) did not have a legislated fee schedule that prescribed oversight fees for Dangerous Goods (DG) entities under the Authority's oversight domain. Since that time, the Air Navigation (Fees for Certificates and Services) Regulation 2022 was promulgated and came into effect on the 1st of May 2022.

2 INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 This notice is to inform industry stakeholders that, effective 1st April 2025, BCAA will implement charges for the oversight services provided to the DG industry locally. This change aligns with our legislated fee schedule, the Air Navigation (Fees for Certificates and Services) Regulation 2022, and reflects our commitment to delivering high-quality regulatory oversight while ensuring Bermuda complies with global standards and recommended practices.
- 2.2 The introduction of these charges will be in accordance with the fee schedule which are designed to support the continued safety and compliance of DG operations within Bermuda's jurisdiction. The fees will be applied to all oversight services, including but not limited to:
 - DG Training programme review and approval; and
 - DG Training programme inspections and audits
